Since design phases began more than three years ago, we have worked closely with our architect and general contractor to build a practical application that will serve as a fraternity house that both our Actives and Alumni can enjoy while also focusing on longevity and using complete commercial construction methods. We have built a house that we believe everyone will enjoy and one that will last a lifetime.

Gamma's new home is nearly 20,000 sq. ft., a building of which the structural components consist of concrete, steel, and impact-resistant sheetrock. The house includes study areas as well as separate gathering and party areas and is located only minutes from downtown and campus. As we begin to focus on the finishing touches, our construction team continues to work towards installing the best, most practical applications for a fraternity house, and those which we believe everyone will appreciate. I would like to extend special thanks to Bill Huff '63, Hoppy Hopkins '69, Larry Knox '65, and Mark Cross '82 for their tireless efforts and countless volunteer hours committed towards overseeing our design and construction project from start to what will soon be the finish.
