Remembering Larry Foote

In the early 1980's, Gamma Chapter of Kappa Alpha Order welcomed a new initiate through the hallowed halls of 294 South Lumpkin. He came with no letters of recommendation. He came with no legacy background. He hadn't been through formal Rush, and he certainly wasn't a blue chipper found spontaneously prior to Fall Quarter while indulging in Athens' finest downtown watering holes. He simply applied for a new job, learning of it's opening through a longtime employee of Gamma, Riley "Coot" Maddox.

Larry Darnell Foote, known throughout most of

his adult life as only "Foote", was employed by the University in its' Facilities Maintenance Division. Working just across Lumpkin from the Mansion, he was in search of something different. Unbeknownst to Gamma at the time, we were in search of something different too, a relationship that would span the course of 30 years, and will never be replicated.

Being from Macon, I knew of Foote before I was out of high school. I'm not sure why, but it seems as though brothers before me and after me from Bibb County were somehow drawn to the man. That's not to say everyone who came across him wasn't, but it felt like the first time I met Larry face to face, I'd known him for a longer time than normal. Stories of a man seen every day, Monday through Friday (although mostly partial days on Friday) at 294 were legendary, both famous and infamous. He was a fixture, someone who was not just at the Mansion, he seemed like he was really a part of the Mansion.



Larry Darnell Foote, born December 9, 1952, died June 18, 2013, remembered forever.

There will never be a shortage of stories regarding Foote. Did he go with you to a football game one of those times where you just didn't want a date? Did he give you a ride to class? Did you find yourself walking through North Campus, hear a horn blast, and look over to see Foote driving YOUR car through the middle of campus? Was he the person you talked to in the Dining Room between classes when no one else was stirring around? Did you lend him twenty dollars? At the end of the day, when it's all said and done, did you by chance learn a portion of what you learned in college,

just by interacting with Foote?

This past summer, thirty or so of us travelled to Athens to pay our last respects. We convened at Jackson McWhorter Funeral Home on Broad Street, and together with Foote's friends and family, we offered our final respect. With half the attendees comprised of Gamma Brothers, you realized just how much Foote meant to Gamma, and possibly more importantly, what Gamma meant to Foote. We were indeed his true friends and family.

If you were to look up the term "generation" in Webster's Dictionary, it would define the term in length of time as "30 years." Foote was a generational employee, having an impact on young men, and their sons across a span of time of employment most in our lifetime will never see. Recent statistics say members of today's "generation" will likely remain in their role of employment for 5 years before changing jobs; Foote beat those marks by an unlikely multiplier of 6.


